Lake Garda

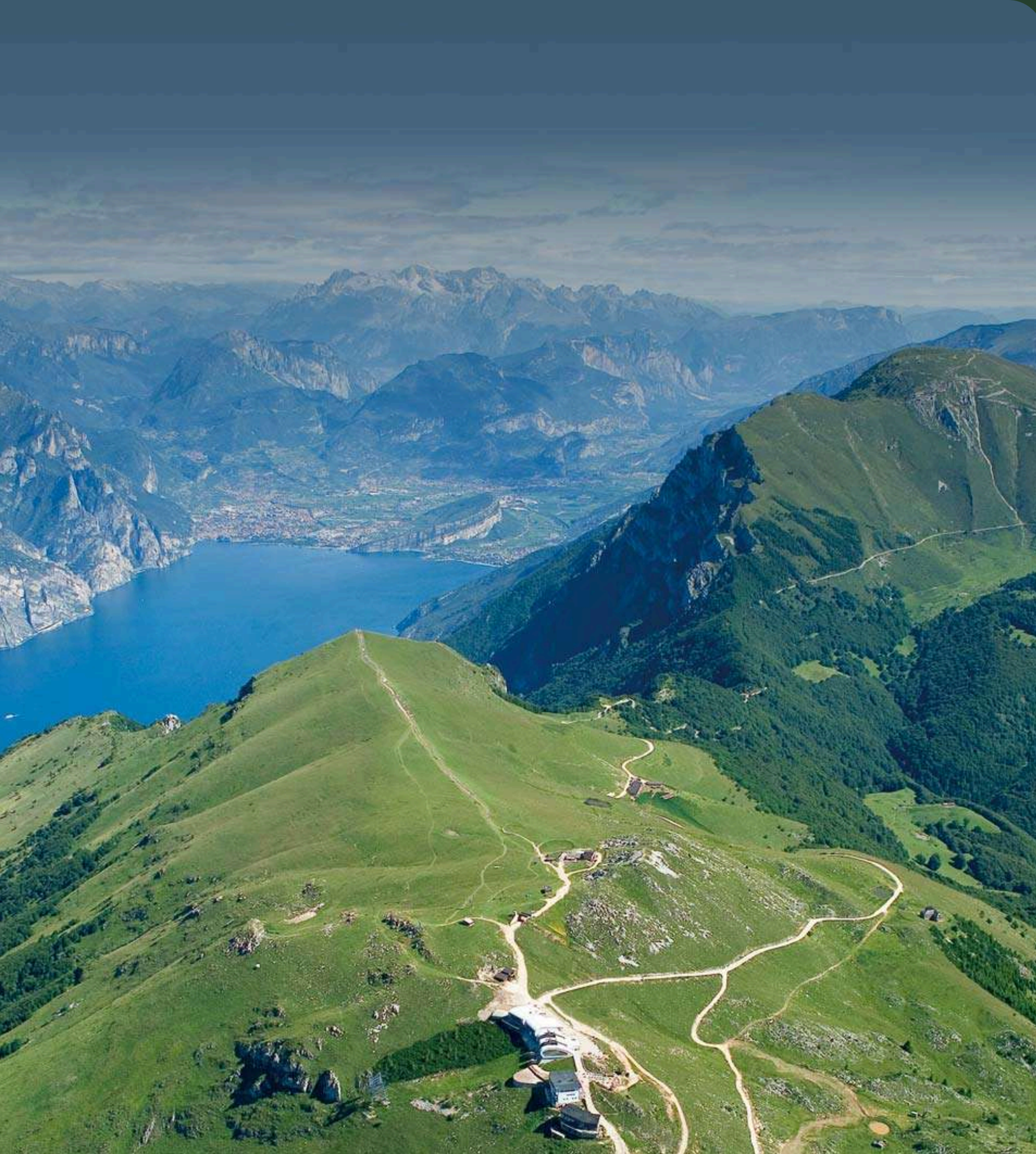
